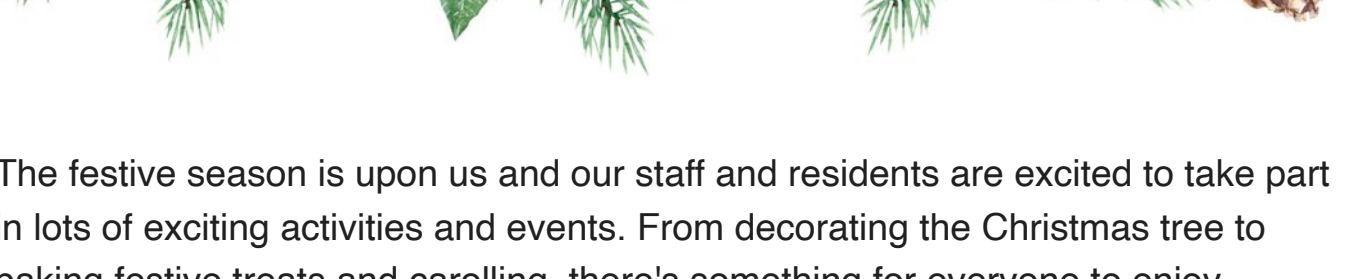




## Welcome To Our Newsletter

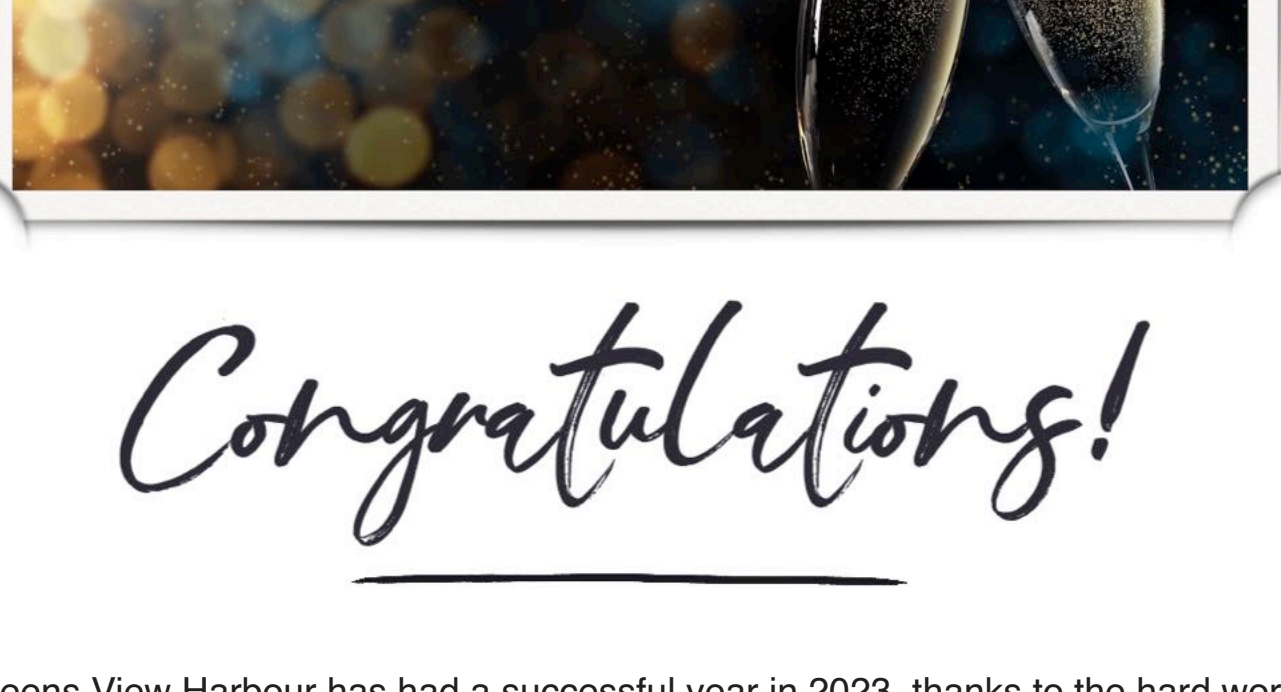

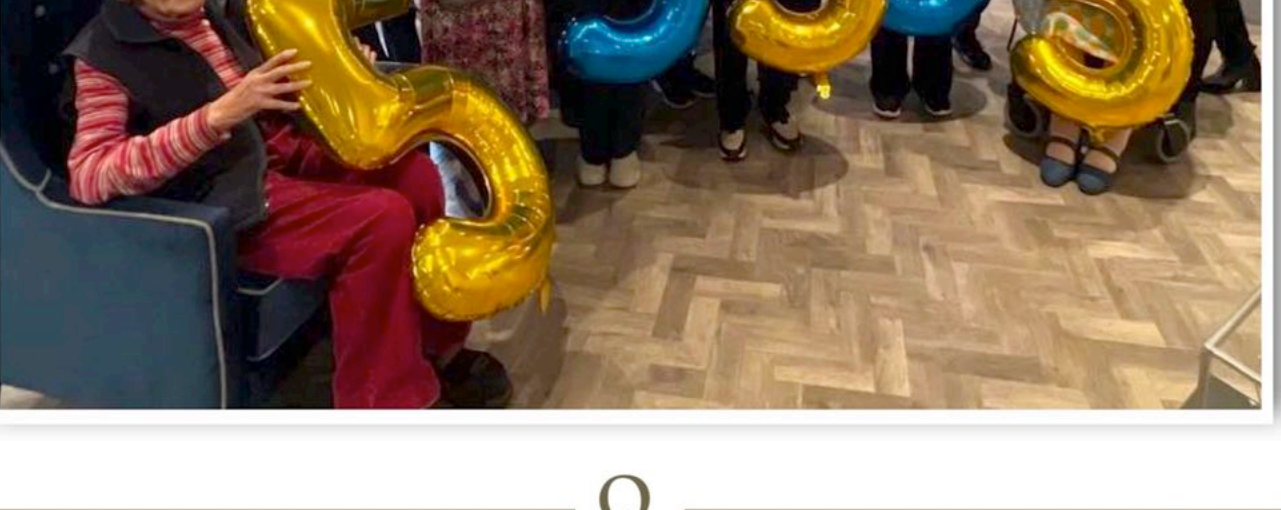


## Care Inspectorate Success

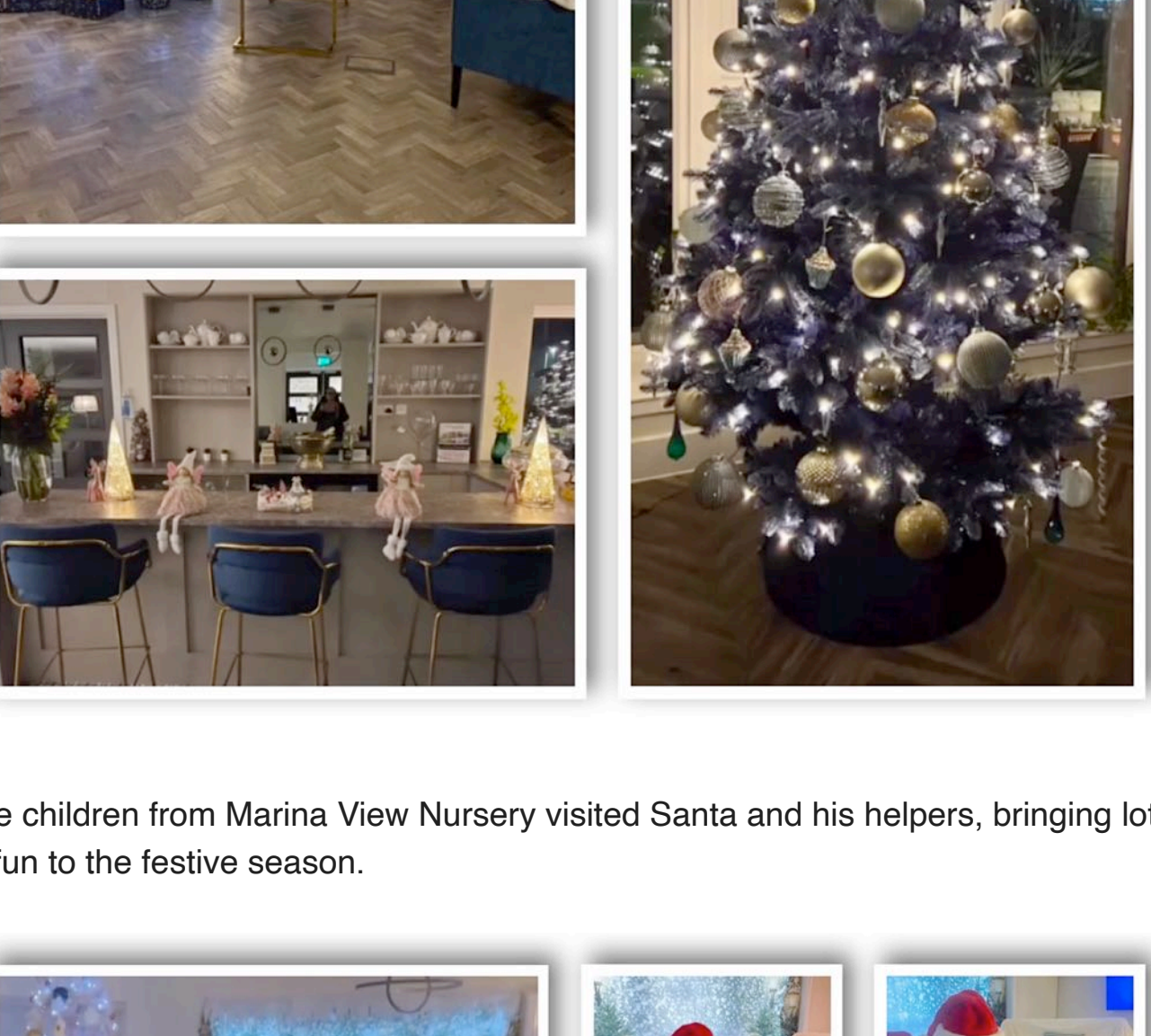

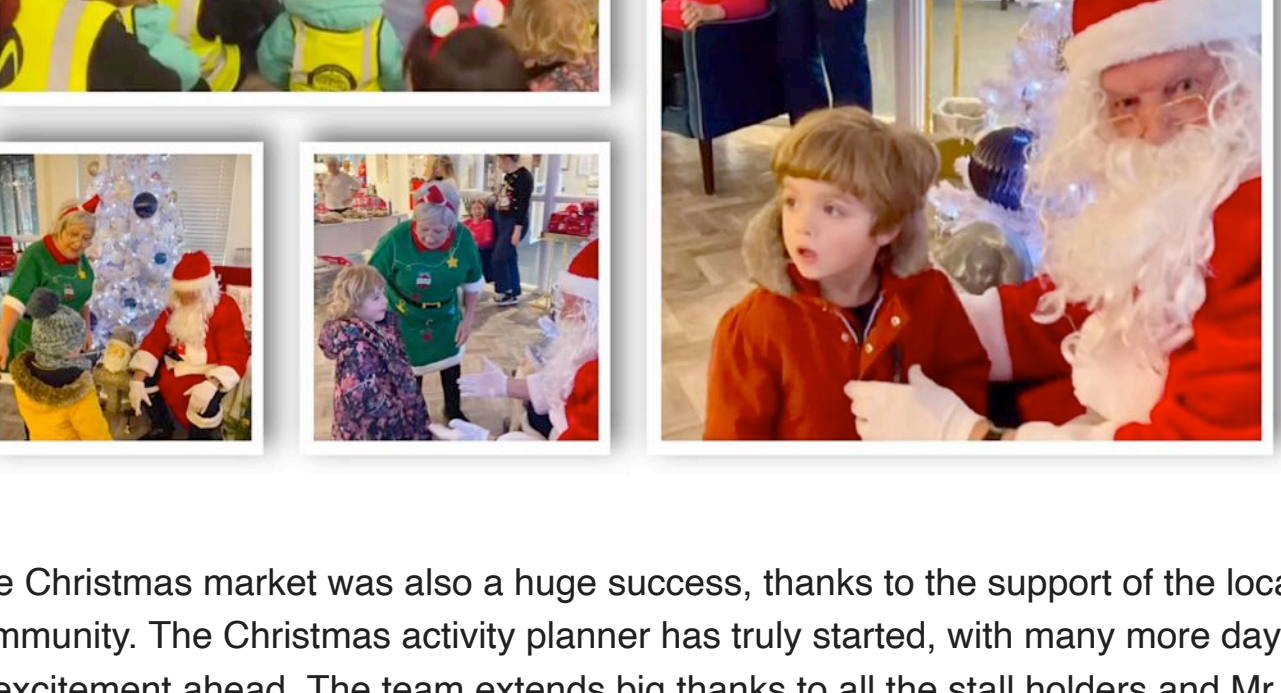


## Getting Prepared...

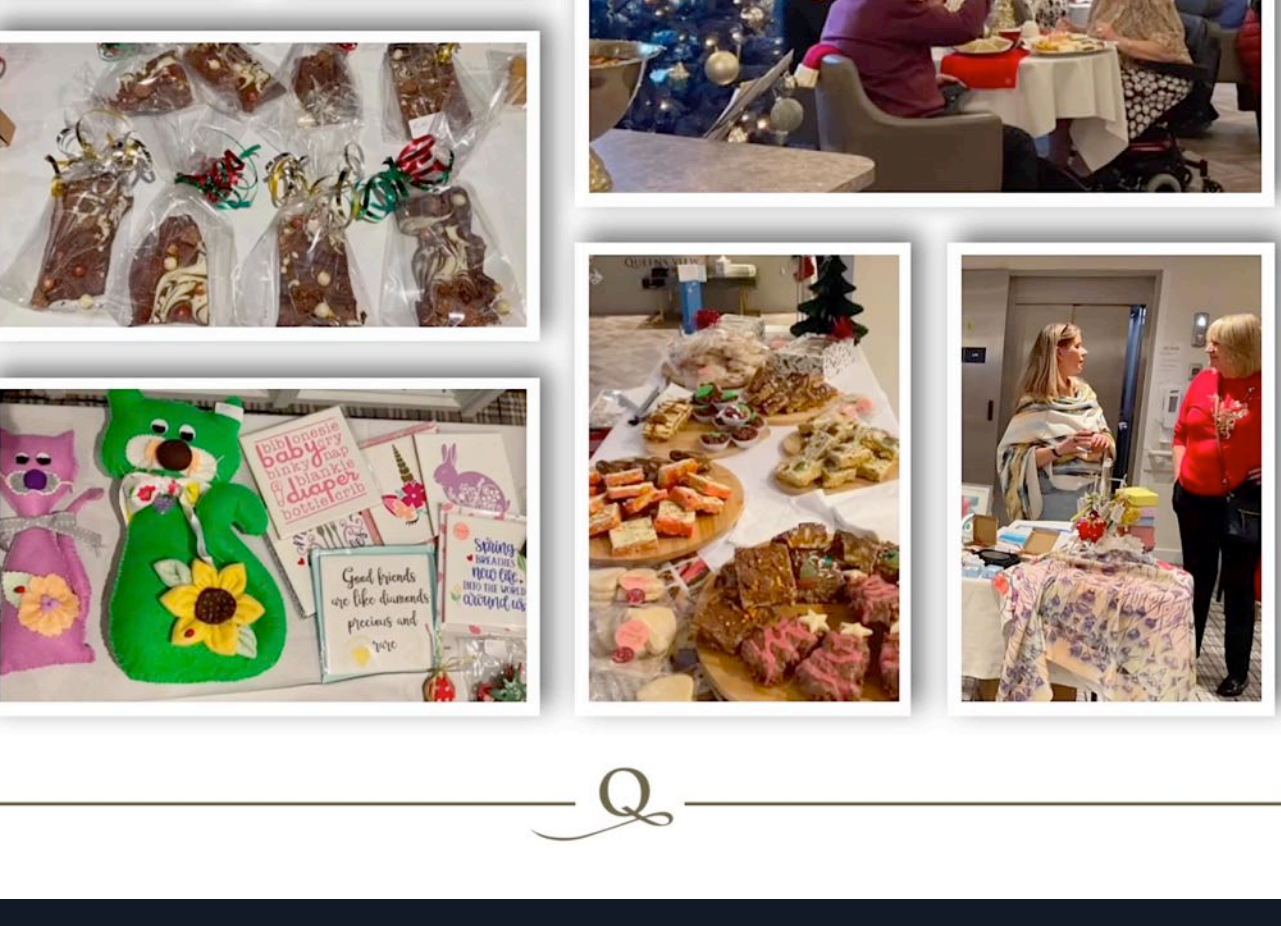
"It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas..." at Queens View Harbour. The trees are up and decorated, and everyone is in the festive spirit.



The children from Marina View Nursery visited Santa and his helpers, bringing lots of fun to the festive season.



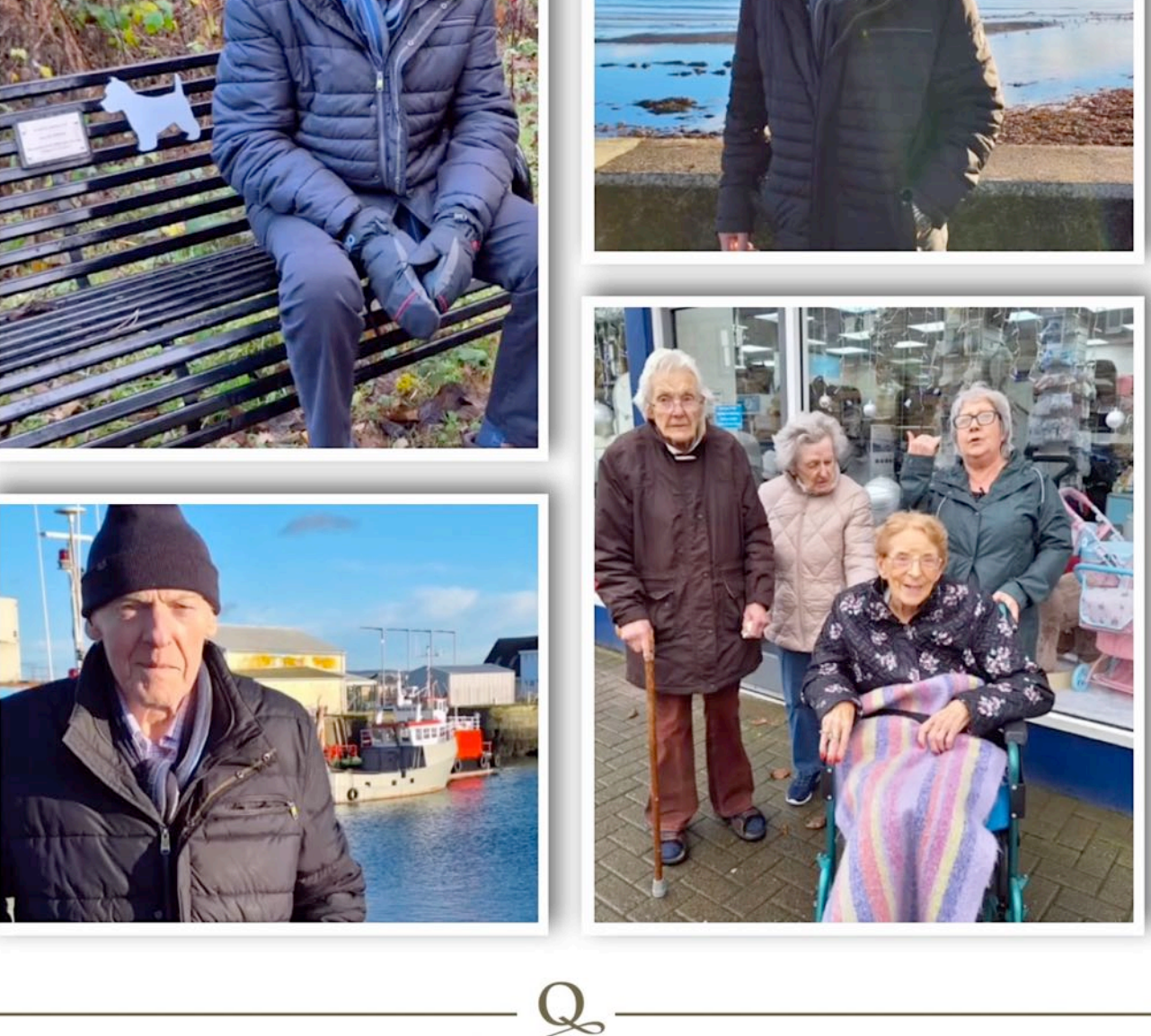

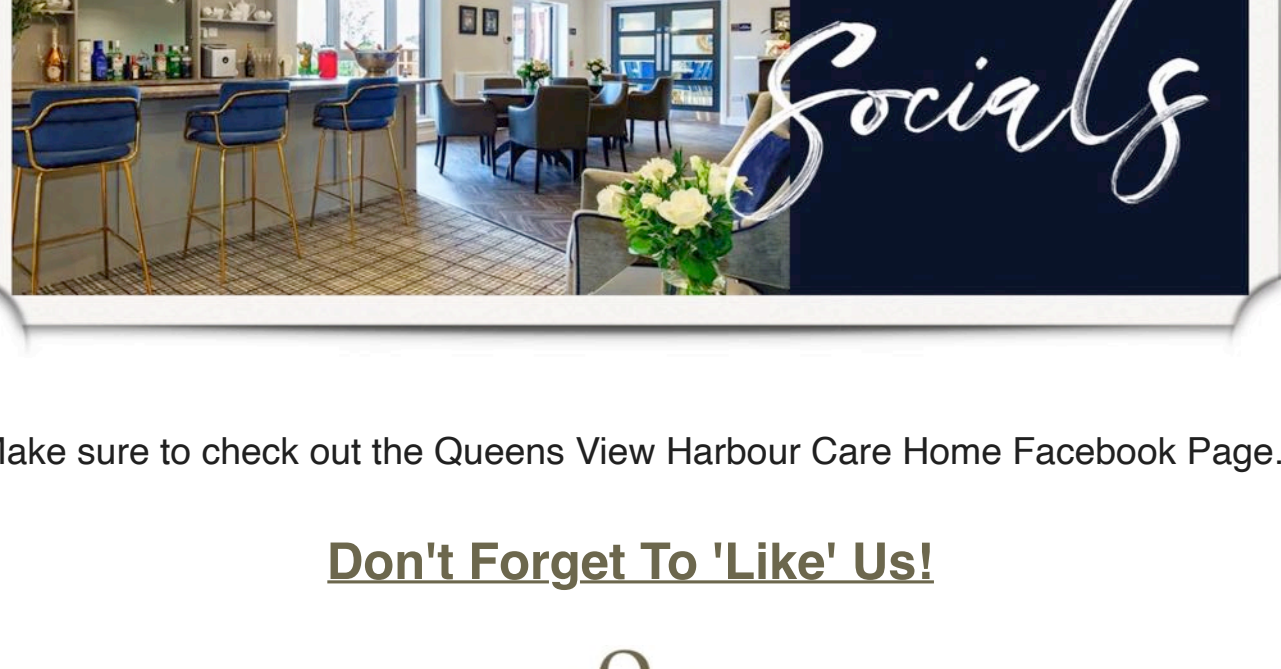
## Chilly Outings

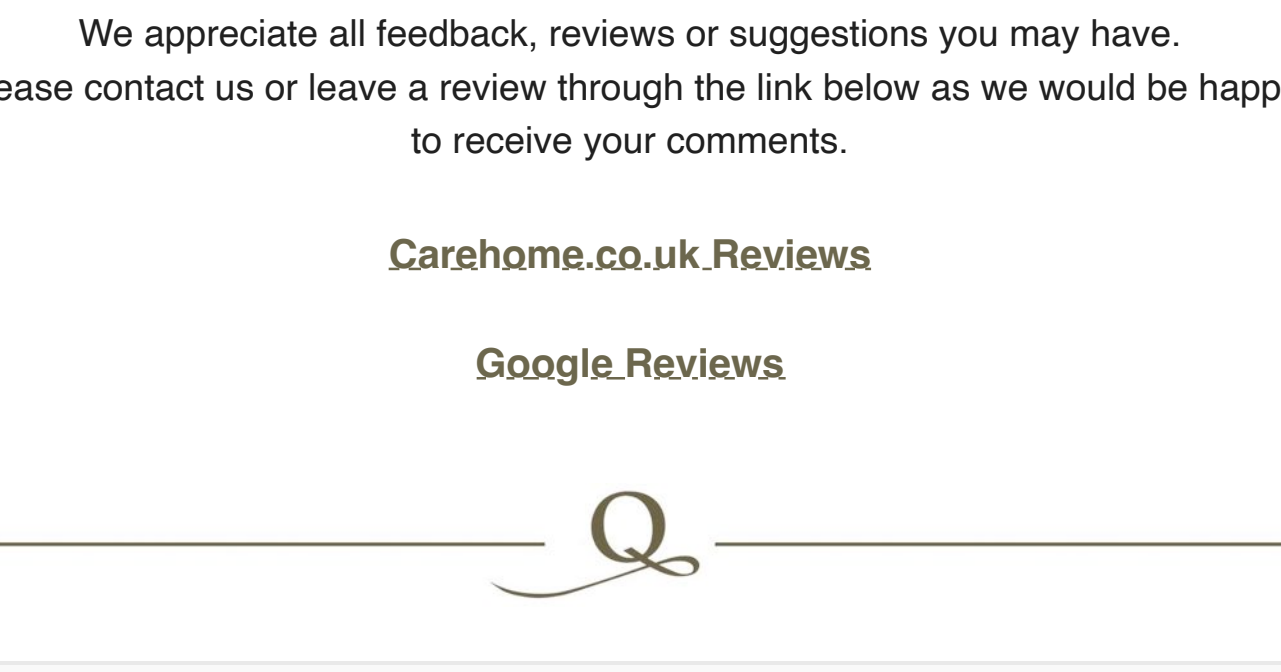
